Students will adhere to the dress code according to our Student/Parent Handbook:

“. . .on other designated days—(*Spirit Days*)—on these days, tank tops, spaghetti straps, see-through, mesh-type, bare midriff tops, muscle shirts, and so forth are not permitted. T-shirts must not have objectionable language or pictures; any items that may be gang related or worn for the expressed purpose of identifying affiliations to gangs are prohibited. Skirts and shorts must be 2” below fingertip length. (This means the length should be past the middle of your thighs.) **No holey jeans. No leggings/tights.**

DRESS CODE: Wear appropriate (as stated above) clothes with your twin or triplets.

We'll celebrate the 100th day of school; usually the elementary will have fun craft activities to commemorate the day.



PENNY WARS: Students can bring the money in the *morning* and place it in a bucket (either place pennies in their bucket which will give their class positive points or place any other silver-colored coins or bills in another class' bucket which will give that class negative points) on their way to lining up. Then, another time to put money in buckets is when parents can place money in the *afternoon* as they enter the gate to pick up their child(ren).

❖ **Tuesday, February 2nd: Celebrate Our Students**

DRESS IN SCHOOL COLORS: burgundy, black, gray, and white and show your school spirit. Students must abide by these dress day rules or risk losing these fun days. (See Student & Parent Handbook excerpt above)
