Dear Parents,

On behalf of our faculty and staff, I would like to welcome all of you to the St. Christopher 2021 – 2022 school year! Beginning a new school year is always exciting. It offers new possibilities and opportunities. I would also like to take this opportunity to offer a warm welcome to our new families. As we begin planning for the coming school year and welcoming everyone back to our campus, we do so with a sense of faith and appreciation for who we are as a strong Catholic community.

Every year brings new changes. First, we would like to welcome Mrs. Kenia Osuna (1st Grade Teacher), Mrs. Mary Joy Mondejar (Kindergarten Teacher), and Mr. Jose Conrad M. Navarra (8th Grade Homeroom/ Middle School Math and Science). We are looking forward to Mrs. Osuna, Mrs. Mondejar and Mr. Navarra sharing their skills and experience with our community. We will continue to have our 4th and 5th grade classrooms shared between Ms. Figueroa and Mrs. Garcia. Ms. Figueroa will continue as the 4th grade homeroom teacher while teaching ELA, Reading, and Social Studies to both 4th and 5th grade. Mrs. Garcia will be the 5th grade homeroom teacher while teaching Math, Science, and Religion to both 4th and 5th grade. In middle school Mrs. Johnson will be the 6th grade homeroom teacher and teaching ELA (Reading, English, and Writing) to 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. Mr. McLain will be the 7th grade homeroom teacher and teaching Social Studies and Religion to 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. Mr. Navarra will be the 8th grade homeroom teacher and teaching Math and Science to 6th, 7th, and 8th grades.

Our school day begins promptly at 8:00 am and concludes at 3:00 pm each day. Any changes to the schedule, including noon dismissal days, will be listed on the **Annual School Calendar**. Please remember that parents are to pick up students at their classrooms at dismissal.

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Back to School Night: At the beginning of each school year we plan a Back to School Night that is designed to give every parent the opportunity to meet with their child's teacher for the very first time. Our orientation includes an overview of the curriculum, class rules, student expectations, grading policies, plans for the new school year, and much more! This year, these meetings will be held in-person (subject to change).

- The elementary Back to School Night (K through 5th Grades) will be held on Tuesday, August 24th at 6:00 PM
- The middle school Back to School Night (6th through 8th Grades) will take place on Wednesday, August 25th at 6:00 PM

Changes in Morning and After Care

Morning Care will be available from 7:15 am for a fee of \$2.00

After Care will be available from 3:15 pm until 6:00 pm. Due to social distancing there will be a limited number of registered students permissible to attend. There will be a \$30 registration fee for every child in aftercare. \$4/hr charge will begin at 3:15 when students are dropped off by their homeroom teachers. *Please note: Morning Care and After Care payments must be made in the School Office.

We will continue to utilize the FACTS Family Portal. This is the most efficient way for us to communicate with all of the families here at St. Christopher. Please be sure to have an updated email address on file in the office and to check your email on a regular basis for communications from the school.

Safe Return to Campus

Once again the Diocese of Las Vegas has been working diligently to amend our re-opening plans in collaboration with the Nevada Department of Education and with guidance from our Diocesan Restoration Advisory Council, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the World Health Organization (WHO). Our goal is to allow students to return to campus in a manner that reduces health-related risks while maintaining an environment in which students, teachers, staff, and families feel safe as we continue to focus on the mission of our school. We will continue to follow all safety guidelines and implement safety protocols and practices in place. **As soon as those plans have been finalized, I will communicate them with you all. We are still planning on 100% returning to in-person learning.**



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Uniforms

Summer Uniforms will be worn by all students at the beginning of the school year.

****All students must wear Summer Uniform on the first day of school.**

Teachers will provide the PE schedules on the first day of school.

Summer Uniform	-Black shorts (must wear solid black belt) -Burgundy polo with St. Christopher logo (shirts must be tucked in) -White socks (must be above ankle) -Solid black tennis shoes with matching laces.
Summer PE Uniform	-Burgundy shorts with St. Christopher logo -Grey PE shirt with St. Christopher logo -Solid white socks (worn above ankle) -Solid black or white tennis shoes with matching laces.

*Please remember that no make-up or jewelry is permitted.

****Also, this is a reminder that all students entering the 7th grade must have their 5th T-dap shot before they may attend class.**

Morning Drop Off

The families will utilize the drop off lane (same lane as before), pull up to the unloading zone outside Gate #1 and drop their children off. Gate #1 is the gate located right next to the school office leading to the blacktop.

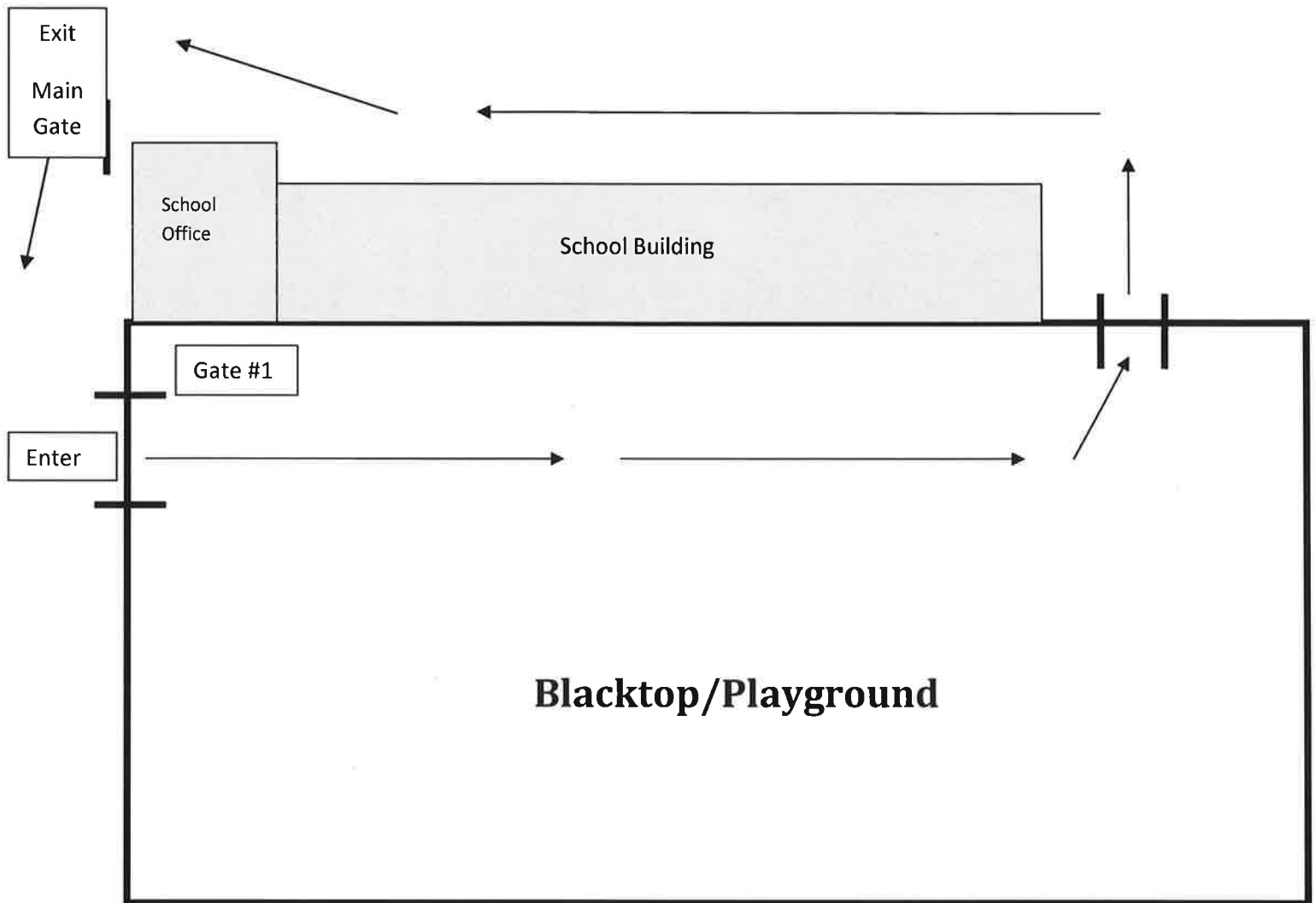
Upon entering Gate #1 the students will walk to their designated classroom room line and line up on a student dot.

Classroom numbers will be painted on the black top 6 feet apart. Student dashes will be painted on the blacktop at 6 foot intervals in a straight line away from the building for each student to stand on.

Gate #1 will open at 7:45 am. Please do not arrive prior to 7:45am. Remain in your car. No parents or visitors are allowed on campus during drop off.

Gate #2 will remain locked during morning drop-off.

The students will be dismissed from their classroom.

The Playground Gate (**Gate #1**) will be opened at 2:50 PM. We ask all parents to enter through this gate and walk around to your child's classroom door.

Parents will line up outside classrooms to pick up students one at a time (following social distancing protocols) at the classroom door. There will be dots outside of the classroom doors to represent 6 feet of social distancing. Parents will not enter the classroom. Older students will also have the option of walking directly to their vehicles with oversight of appropriate personnel. The parents will exit the campus immediately after picking up their students through the **main gate** by the office. There will be no congregating on the campus.
